








A variety of other performers from around the country

The Town Sneaker, which leaves from and returns to Matsumoto Station, is convenient for sightseeing within the city.

Fare: One ride 190 yen for adults / 100 yen for children Operation Time: 9am - 6pm

Operation Interval: The Town Sneaker Bus Leaving Matsumoto Station Oshiroguchi (East Exit) (the Northern Route) 30min intervals (leaving on the hour and the half hour)

- When you come, take the Town Sneaker Bus on the Northern Route and get off at Daimyocho Bus Stop.
- When you leave the restrival, local buses which go to Matsumoto Station are available from Daimyocho Bus Stop.
