




Kamikochi (meaning roughly "where the gods descended") is the prime attraction of the Chubu Sangaku National Park and an ideal starting point for many alpine adventures. The park's highlights include spectacular alpine scenery, a live volcano, primeval forests, and the Azusa River, whose azure waters flow from the very heart of the mountains. The central area is located about 1,500 m above sea level, and surrounded by mountain peaks reaching to an additional 1,500 m and beyond. There are a variety of exciting options for hikers of all levels and the majestic mountains can be admired from afar or up close!

## Climate



Kamikochi has a relatively high number of fine days except for the rainy season through June to mid July. However the mountain weather changes rapidly, and showers and thunder storms are prone to occur especially in the after-

The temperature difference within a day is significant. It sometimes gets fairly cold especially in the mornings and evenings of spring and fall.

### **Accumulated Snow**

Snow accumulated over the winter on the walking trail to Tokusawa is 1 to 1.5 m on average. Some areas may remain covered in snow until early May depending on locations and the weather that year

The winter snowfall beyond Tokusawa is heavy and there is snow or ice on the climbing trail between October and June. Clothing and equipment as well as winter mountain climbing experience are required.

## Tips

- Transport is non-JR. The Japan Rail Pass is not valid on the
- You can buy two-day or four-day discount passes at the bus terminals (not JR stations) of Matsumoto and Shin-shimashima. The four-day pass can also be purchased at the bus centers of Takayama and Gero.
- Two-Day Free Passport Kamikochi / Norikura (5,000 yen for adults) covers Kamikochi, Shirahone, Norikura, Matsumoto, Asama Hot Springs, and Utsukushigahara.
- Four-Day Alps Wide Shinshu/Hida Free Passport (10.000 ven.) for adults) covers Hida Takayama, Shirakawago, Shinhotaka Hot Springs, and Gero Hot Springs, in addition to the Two-Day Free Passport areas.

You can buy a ticket for the Kamikochi Line at either of the two machines on the left hand side of the ticket machine area in Matsumoto Station.

Press the "English" button to buy a ticktet with directions in English.

On entering the ticket gate, you will find a blue display for platform 7 for the Kamikochi line.





# Short Stays

Clothing

Wear suitable walking shoes such as sneakers because many of the walking trails are unpaved. Wear clothes that you don't mind getting dirty because you may be active, sitting down on the riverside or walking for a long time.

It is recommended that you bring additional outer clothes for managing body temperature in the changeable mountain weather. Never forget to bring rainwear.

### Long Stays

During your stay in Kamikochi, layered clothing is recommended for managing body temperature because the temperatures differ greatly between daytime and nighttime.

Separate-type rainwear (preferably waterproof and moisturepermeable fabric), which you can also use as a windbreaker, would be for walking comfortably in the rain.
