

## $\blacksquare$ Buses in the City and Surrounding Area

Buses bound for various destinations depart from the bus terminal, which you will see to the right across the street when you exit Matsumoto Station.

You can purchase the bus ticket to your destination at the ticket counter or ticket machines at Matsumoto Bus Terminal, or you can pay on the bus when you get off. Credit cards are accepted at the Bus Terminal, but not on the bus.

## 🚊 Train

To go towards Nagano from Matsumoto Station, take the JR Shinonoi Line. To go towards Hotaka (Azumino), Omachi, or Hakuba, take the JR Oito Line. To go towards Shinjuku (Tokyo), take the JR Chuo Tosen Line. To go towards Nagoya, take the JR Chuo Saisen Line. To go towards Shin-Shimashima Station at the foot of Kamikochi, take the Kamikochi Line of the Matsumoto Electric Railway from Track 7.

# **Rental Bicycles**

'HELLO CYCLING' and 'Sui Sui Town' are available at various locations throughout town.

### HELLO CYCLING (bike-share)

This bike sharing service allows you to rent and return bicycles to designated bike parking racks at any time of day.

20 or more spots are available around the city at places like next to the roundabout in front of Matsumoto Station's Castle (East) Exit.

Rate: **¥60**/15 min (max. **¥1,000**/day) Rent/return hours: 24-hour \* Rates may vary with the season \* Rental/return times may vary with location

## 🖵 Free Internet Terminals & Wi-Fi

There are two Tourist Information Centers: one across from the ticket gates in the Matsumoto Station building and the other just south of Matsumoto Castle. Free Wi-Fi that does not require a password is available at both centers. It is also available at the Matsumoto Station plaza, Flower Clock (Hanadokei) Park, the Matsumoto City Museum of Art, Otemon Parking Lot, Matsumoto Castle Park, Matsumoto Castle's Honmaru Garden, the Former Kaichi School, Nawate Street and Kurassic-kan on Nakamachi Street. There are also computers with internet access in the Tourist Information Center south of Matsumoto Castle.

#### Asama Hot Springs

This hot spring area has a long history dating back 1,300 years as a well-loved retreat for the people of Matsumoto. Day-trip bathing is available.

Access: 20 min. from Matsumoto Bus Terminal on the Asama Hot Springs-bound bus

### **5** Shirahone Hot Springs

This hot spring nestled in the deep mountains is famous for its opaque white water. Bathing in the fresh green or fall foliage, whatever the season gives a wonderful feeling of freedom.

Access: 30-min train ride from Matsumoto Station followed by a 60-min bus ride.





## **2** Utsukushigahara Hot Springs

We know that this area has been a popular spa area since olden times since its activities were recorded in ancient documents. One nice thing is that the hot spring temperature is not too hot.

Access: 20 min. from Matsumoto Bus Terminal on the Utsukushigahara Hot Springs-bound bus



#### Kamikochi & the Japan Alps

Kamikochi is a place of untouched natural beauty. It's certainly a great destination for walking, trekking, and camping. An overnight stay here will allow visitors to experience an uninterrupted view of the night sky with brightly shining stars.

Access: 30-min. train ride from Matsumoto Station followed by a 60-min. bus ride



**C** Norikura Kogen (Plateau) Norikura Kogen is located on a plateau at an elevation of between 1200 and 1800 meters. It offers different seasonal activities over the whole year. The Snow Wall walking in May and June, trekking & camping in summer, viewing the changing colors of autumn, and skiing or snowshoe-ing in winter. Access: 30-min. train ride from Matsumoto Station followed by a 50-min. bus ride For the snow walls, an additional 50-min ride
